


Halifax County Electoral Board

February 2, 2023

The Halifax County Electoral Board met on February 2, 2023 in the Registrar's office in Halifax, Virginia. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Paul Smith at 11:10 a.m. The chair made the motion to accept the agenda for today's meeting and Ellen Kent seconded. The motion passed. The chair called for the minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting on January 9, 2023 were read and approved. Matthew Cunningham motioned to accept the minutes as read and Paul Smith seconded. The motion passed. Next item on the agenda was the public comment. There was no public comment. The chair called for old business. The Board discussed the 'Ballot on Demand' project and decided to wait until later to try it before approval.

The chair called for new business. The board discussed the appointment of the list of officers for the year 2023, and the Registrar Heather Harding stated that she would mail each election official a form to fill out stating their intent to work. Ellen Kent made a motion to accept the decision to send out a formed letter for intent to work and Matthew Cunningham seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Next discussion was the new precinct for Midway District 7 which was split due to redistricting. The County Attorney suggested splitting Midway precinct and Paul Smith made the motion to consider splitting the current precinct to precinct A and B and maintain the same facility. Matthew Cunningham seconded and the motion passed. The Registrar stated that she would not be sure of a June Primary for the Senate and House of Delegates until April. The board decided the next meeting will be held on April 13th, at 11:00 a.m. With no more new business to discuss, Matthew Cunningham motioned to adjourn the meeting and Paul Smith seconded. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 11:50 a.m.


