September 16, 2025

The Halifax County Electoral Board met on September 16, 2025 in the Registrar's office in Halifax, Virginia. The meeting was call to order at 11:15 a.m. by the Chair, Korey Snead with all members present. The agenda for today's meeting was approved and there was no public comment. The Chair called for the minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved with no opposes. The chair called for old business. There was some discussion on moving the Mt. Carmel and Black Walnut polling location. The board decided to visit the Mt Carmel location on September 29th or 30th and the Black Walnut location around the first week of October, 2025. The chair called for new business. The chair made remarks regarding pay raises for election officials in order to comply with Virginia Law by January 1, 2026. The chair then made a motion to increase the pay by \$60.00 to begin in January 2026. Secretary Ellen Kent seconded with no opposes. The motion passed. Kayla Wade also made a second motion to adjust the election officials pay by \$60.00 for the remainder of 2025. The chair Korey Snead seconded and the motion passed. The Registrar Heather Harding asked that the board members complete their list of workers and turn them in by next Tuesday. The L&A on the early voting machines was done by the board with the early voting machines in compliance with state laws and procedures. The date for the L & A on all other voting equipment for the November 4, 2025 General Election is scheduled for October 22, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. With no further business at hand, Chairman Korey Snead motioned to adjourn the meeting with no opposes. The meeting was adjourned at 12:27 p.m.
