In lieu of submission of an erosion & sediment control plan on this lot, I agree to comply with the requirements of the Virginia Erosion & Sediment Control Law & Regulations, as amended, and install those measures in accordance with the most recent Virginia E & S Control Handbook Standards and Specifications in order to protect against the transportation of soil off of the property. I further agree to comply with additional requirements determined necessary by the County of Halifax. Such requirements shall be based on minimum standards necessary to provide adequate control of erosion and sedimentation resulting from this development.

**At a minimum, ALL denuded areas on the lot shall be stabilized within seven (7) days of final grading with permanent vegetation or a protective ground cover suitable for the time of year. Temporary soil stabilization shall be applied within seven (7) days to denuded areas that may not be at final grade but will remain dormant (undisturbed) for longer than fourteen (14) days.

**I further understand that failure to comply with such requirements within the timeframe required by the Halifax County Staff could result in appropriate legal action being taken to insure compliance with the Erosion & Sediment Control Law & Regulations and the Virginia Erosion & Sediment Control Handbook. The submission and approval of an erosion control plan and/or posting of a performance bond could be required.
