TUESDAY, November 7, 2023: ELECTION DAY- All Absentee voted ballots must be returned to the Halifax County Voter Registration and Elections Office by 7 PM to be counted or be postmarked by November 7, 2023 and received by noon on November 13, 2023.

By mail ballots may be dropped in the ballot drop box located at the Voter Registration Office, 1030 Mary Bethune Street, LL3, Halifax, VA 24558.
